## SUPPLY LIST FOR CERAMICS WORKSHOP:

I will have tools and we can share, so don't worry too much about finding all the tools on the list. You can wait until after the first class to buy supplies.

- 1. Container for storing your tools.
- 2. Basic throwing tools, including some small sponges, any ribs you may have, wooden, metal or rubber, needle tool (most valuable and needed tool, maybe buy 2). Towel for your lap.
- 3. Basic hand-building modeling tools. Scoring tool (serrated rib) Small brushes for applying slip- cheap are fine- any size. Any molds you may have for slab projects.

Any other tools you may have for incising or impressing clay. Pony or pastry roller (goodwill sometimes has them) fettling knife. Plastic or dry cleaning bags to cover your work. I like the rolling pins that don't have pins (I think they are pastry rollers)

4. A notebook for taking notes, drawing designs. Any images of work you would be interested in making.
