The Borough of Manhattan Community College and partner Lehman College have created short-term credential programs and courses meant to provide pathways to employment in the Cannabis industry. BMCC will focus on the following three specific workforce training programs:

Cannabis Security Solutions



Individuals completing the Security Guard training certificate program will be able to:

- ▶ Operate Security cameras.
- ▶ Man guards inside and outside of dispensaries.
- ▶ Operate as Security patrols at cannabis growing facilities.
- ▶ Defuse misunderstandings and potentially hostile confrontations.

Advanced Manufacturing Technician



This program serves as a thorough training to the job role of the manufacturing agent. This certificate program will provide a broader overview of:

- ▶ Optimizing post processes.
- ▶ Optimize health and safety procedures.
- ▶ Foundations of cannabis infusion, product development and formulation.
- ▶ Understanding cannabis extraction methodologies.

Advanced Dispensary Associate



A range of topics will be covered in this course including: The business of cannabis extraction, product development, product safety, pest control, storage and more. Individuals completing this certificate program will be able to:

- ▶ Define compliance and operational excellence.
- ▶ Identify the various cannabis products and delivery methods available to the customer.
- ▶ Analyze plant and human biology in relation to cannabis.
- ▶ Optimize health and safety procedures and more.
